If serving people outside the parish, explain why and how the parish community benefits: Our project benefits people of all ages (with volunteers ranging in age from 0 to 92!) and is open to absolutely everyone. Beneficiaries include our volunteers, who report multiple positive health and wellbeing outcomes from joining us, our customers who have access to affordable healthy veg grown without chemicals, our wider community including people who visit for workshops, activities and events and local schools who bring children to our site to learn about food and nature. The majority of activities take place on our site at the Ecopark, Porthtowan, but we also do some outreach work in local schools. Some volunteers and customers come from outside the parish, but this still benefits our parish, as these people help us to create a thriving community market garden in our area.

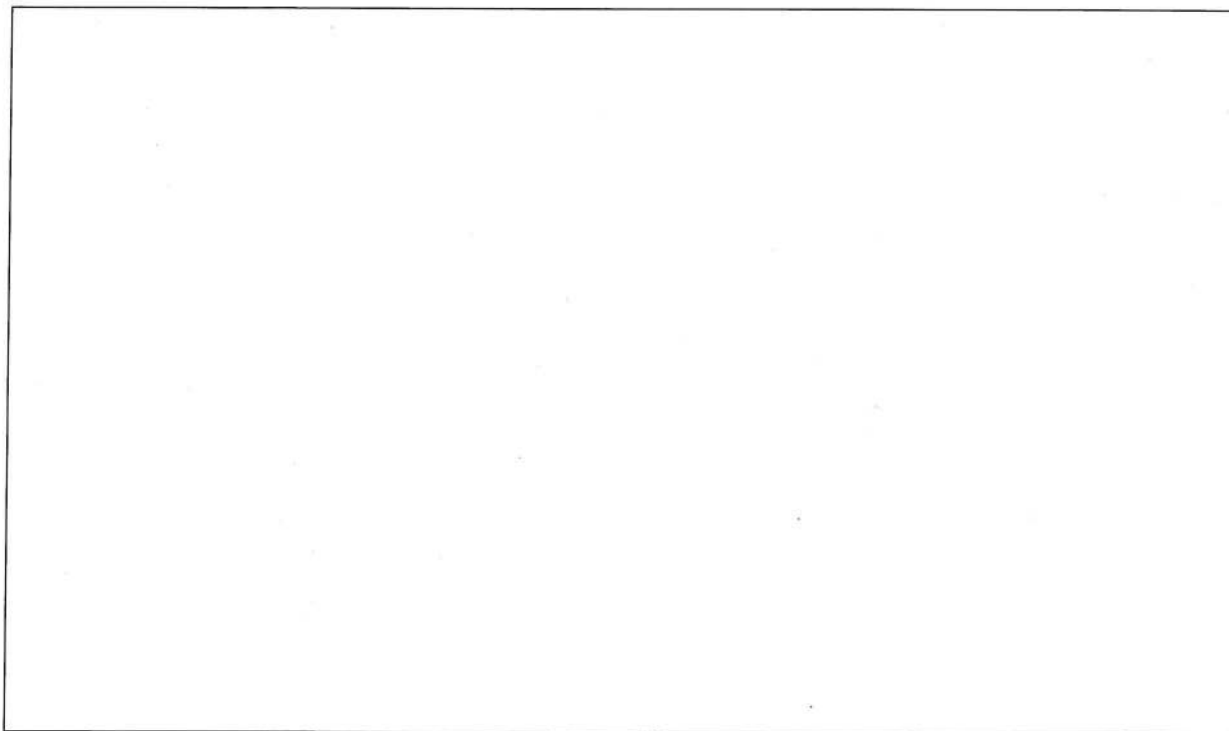

Who will manage the project? The project will be overseen by our board of Directors, and will be delivered by our Communications Lead.

Community Roots benefits the parish of St Agnes in many ways. We run a regular volunteer day, which is attended by around 30 people per week from a pool of over 100 regular volunteers, most of whom live in Saint Agnes parish. We run a veg bag scheme with affordable options for local people. We also run activities around education and training, helping people to understand the links between food and the environment and we engage with Mount Hawke and Blackwater primary schools. The work we do has an incredible impact on the mental and physical health of the people who engage with our project and a significant positive effect on the environment in our local area, both in terms of the way that we grow the veg on our plot and the education that we provide people around working closely with nature and the importance of this. This project will pay for us to produce marketing materials to promote our project and explain the services and activities that we offer within our parish. We recognise that lots of people don't engage with social media, particularly the older generations, and we want to make our project as accessible as possible by reaching out in different, more traditional ways including posters and leaflets. We also want to create materials that we can take with us when we go along to other organisations and events so that we can promote the work that we do, and make sure that as many people in our local area have access to what we provide and understand what we're doing, and why.
